Congratulations to Louis Suc for securing the part of Eric in Matilda due to hit the West End this autumn.

Louis went through a very gruelling audition process involving no less than 3 separate auditions and a final meeting with producers before being offered the part. Louis will be in one of three teams of children's casts that will perform throughout the week over a six month period.

Matilda is a brand new musical written by Dennis Kelly and Tim Minchin based on the famous Roald Dahl book of the same name. It has had an extremely successful run at The Courtyard Theatre in Stratford-upon-Avon, and now the Royal Shakespeare Company are transferring the production to the Cambridge Theatre in London's West End.

Reviews for the production have hailed it the best musical in recent years.

Matilda tells the story of an young girl with a love for reading and extraordinary powers! The story of Matilda delights both children and adults.

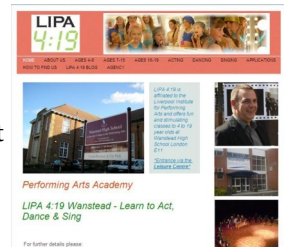
The Theatre Club is an optional extra and open to students, parents and friends—and of course you are free to choose which trips you would like to go on.
